

Building Usage Regulations

FOOD: Our Synagogue is kept dairy /vegetarian. No meat, poultry, or non-kosher type of fish is allowed. The menu or food items must be approved by the Rabbis and/or Temple Administrator. The kitchen may not be used by renters, except as a set-up, clean-up, and distribution space, unless otherwise discussed with the Rabbis and Temple Administrator.

Alcohol: Alcohol (except for ritual use) is prohibited in the Temple or on Temple property.

Prohibitions: Illegal drugs and substances are strictly prohibited in or on Temple property. Temple Sinai is a smoke-free facility. Smoking is not permitted in any part of the Temple facility, or within ten feet of Temple entrances.

Decorations: No staples, tacks, nails, or screws may be used to attach decorations. All decorations must be removed by renter at the end of event. **The following decorations are not allowed:** Decorative candles, confetti, silly string, and bubble or smoke machines.
